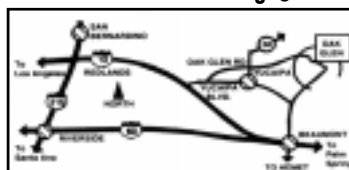

# Southern California Fair

## Country Group 'Trick Pony' Comes To The SC Fair



The annual Southern California Fair brings 9 days of activities to the Lake Perris Fairgrounds, including five nights of concerts in the Coors

Arena. The fair, known formerly as the Farmers Fair & Festival, runs Oct. 16 - 24.

Country Group "Trick Pony" will perform Thursday, Oct. 21 at 7:30pm. Trick Pony was formed in 1996 with the trio of Ira Dean, Keith Burns and Heidi Newfield. By 2001 they were a finalist in Billboard Music Awards for New Country Artist of The Year. It wasn't long after that they had their number one single "On A Night Like This."

In 2002, the trio was named Top New Vocal Duo/Group by the Academy of Country Music and Favorite New Country Artist by the American Music Awards.


Things didn't slow down for them the next year as they garnered a Grammy nomination for Best Country Performance By A Duo or Group for their song "Just What I Do."

"Having a band with such success and energy like Trick Pony will be a great act to have," Lyndal Graff, CEO/Secretary Manager of the Southern California Fair, said. "With country music very popular in this area, we are hoping people will have a great time at the fair."

Trick Pony is one of five musical acts to headline the fair's concert series. Kicking off the fair's concert series will be The Beach Boys on Monday, October 18 and continues with Phil Vassar on Tuesday, October 19, Chris LeDoux on Wednesday, October 20, Trick Pony on Thursday, October 21, and Newsboys on Friday, October 22.

Motorized events are scheduled on the weekends of the fair with the

Monster Truck Show on opening day, Saturday, October 16 and the PRCA Rodeo on Sunday, October 17. 

# Catch the Wing

*Air museum brings old planes back to life*

**C**atch the flying wing take to the sky at the Chino Airport as part of their "Planes of Fame" program.

The Chino Airport Air Museum will focus on flight test operations at the Nov. 6 event, with a seminar on the history of aircraft flight test operations. If the weather permits, the seminar will conclude with a demonstration of the

"Planes of Fame" Northrop N9MB flying wing, a World War II development aircraft that actually was the precursor of today's Northrop B-2A Spirit stealth bomber.

Perhaps the most critical phase of an aircraft's development, flight testing of new designs and modifications to existing designs is essential. In the early days of aviation, the first test pilots were often also the designers and builders of the aircraft that they were testing. The Wright Brothers can be considered to be the first successful test pilots as well as the inventors of powered flight.


An independent, non-profit, educational institution, The Air Museum "Planes of Fame" was the first permanent

air museum in the American west and a pioneer in the concept of restoring museum display aircraft to flying condition, a concept that is now practiced worldwide.

"I worked the whole summer in a campground, keeping it clean, raking pine needles – anything to get the cash," he said.

He saved his pay and by the end of the summer had \$395 to buy his first dirt bike.

"I was on top of the world!" The then ten-year-old said he was so excited he couldn't sleep.

His parents used the bike to keep him on the straight and narrow. "Every time I screwed up, it was three weeks to a month with no motorcycle and I thought I would die," Perlin said.

Now Perlin can ride as wild as he likes – and the crowds love it. **R**
